1) FINAL Project

Due Monday 6 June at 9.30 am (in lieu of final exam)

Each student will develop a final project that critically examines an aspect of digital media ... Students must develop a topic proposal that consists of an abstract and rationale ... (done already!)

The final project will be evaluated based on completeness, critical thought, originality, creativity, readability and, of course, grammar/punctuation/spelling. Writing should be professional (not anecdotal).

All projects must include at least eight external references; a minimum of three must be scholarly (academic) references and at least two must be reputable media (not personal web sites). All projects must include an annotated bibliography. We will use APA for citations.

Students who wish to develop a portfolio website for this project must also write an scholarly essay on a subject related to their wish for employment. This could be an examination of the types of careers offered, a historical analysis of the field, or a treatise on how to find a job. See me for more details. [Added 3 April 2005]

NOTE:

Earlier in the quarter, I rescinded the requirement that the project be delivered via HTML after I realized that I could not adequately cover Dreamweaver in the class.

Except for those completing a portfolio (which must be delivered via HTML), you can deliver your final project via a Word document, a PDF, a web page/site (html), or a series of blog postings. It is your choice.

Your first and second assignments were integral steps towards the completion of this project.

Presentations:

I had hoped to have time for each student to make a formal presentation to the class about their individual project. However, instead, on Wednesday 1 June - each student will have three (3) minutes to informally present their topic and their learnings.

For extra credit - blog a 500 word summary of project thesis and conclusions. Also due at 9.30 am 6 June; writing quality graded on the same criteria as overall project.

2) THIRD assignment

The third assignment deals with new media and society and should have already been linked from the assignments page. However, the link is not there. :-/

I can't link it now because it's on my office PC, not my personal laptop.

It was also not supposed to be due until Wednesday 1 June (not 27 May). It will be linked before class Monday -- and we can talk then about whether or not 1 June is a reasonable due date.
