<i>Total Fertility Rate</i> (TFR) is the average number of children born per woman of child bearing years					
$TFR = \frac{\text{Total # of Children}}{\text{Number of Women}} \times 1000$					
Biological Maximum TFR for humans is about 8 but can be much lower depending on health status.



	<ul> <li>Of potential mothers, such as their age when married, occupation, education, health</li> </ul>	
*	Family Factors	
	➤ such as existing children, social class, income, religion	
*	Societal Factors	
	<ul> <li>Such as education, economic opportunity, medical and public health systems, norms, ethnicity</li> </ul>	
*	Geographical Factors	
	<ul> <li>such as urban or rural, standards of housing, available natural resources, weather, and various forms of exchange between regions.</li> </ul>	


