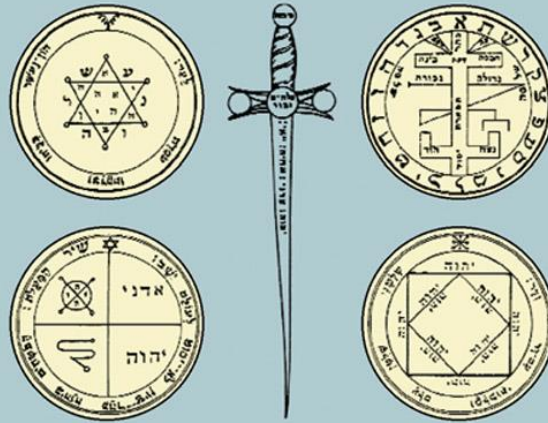

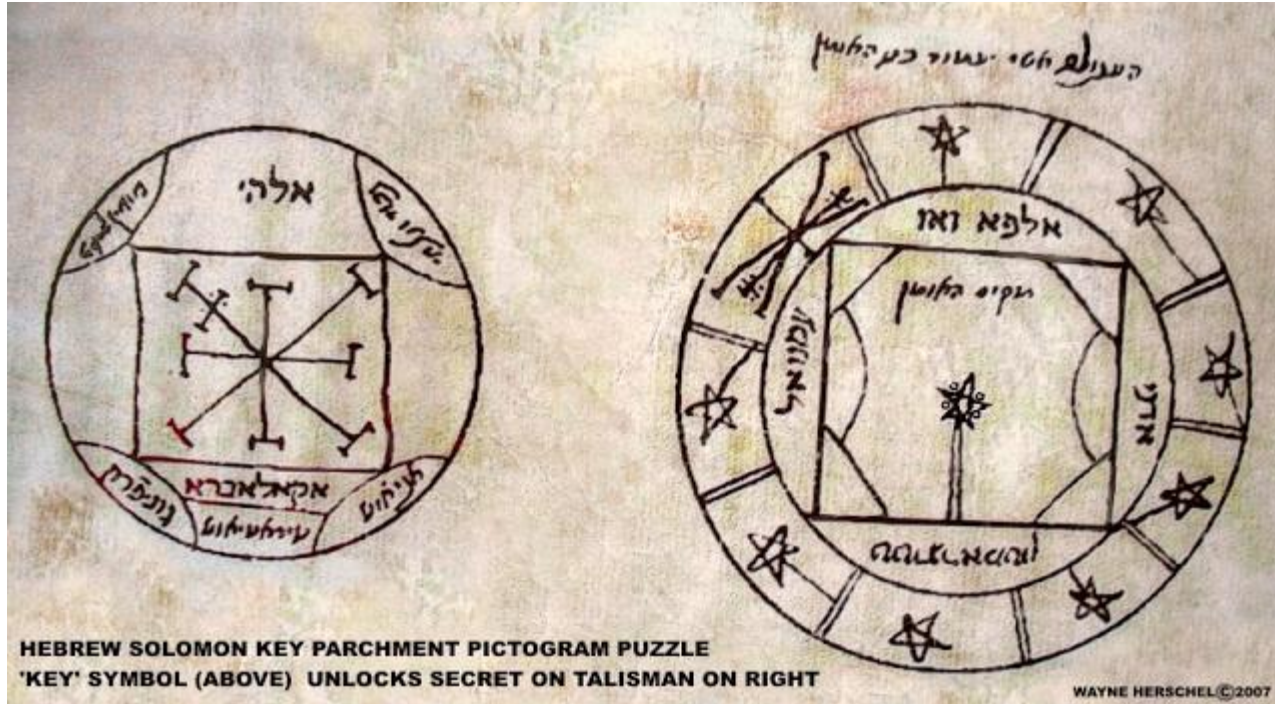

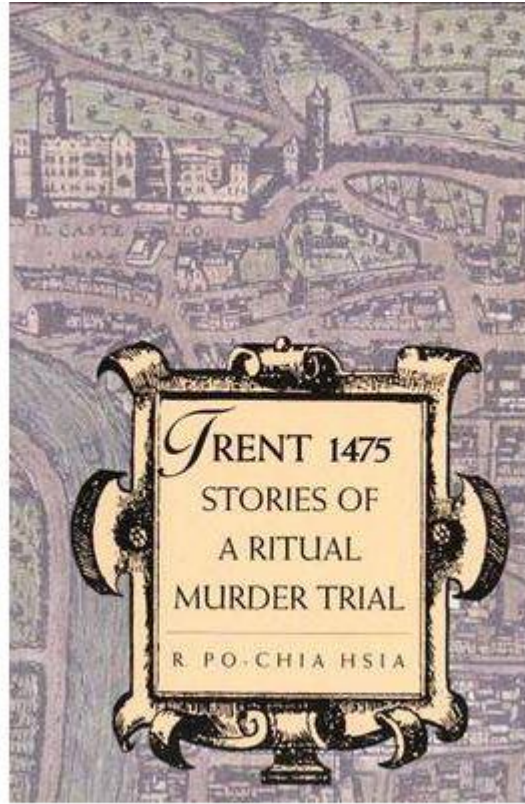




Use of Hebrew characters as magical symbol
