

Final Project Presentation (P6) Feedback

Due Monday, December 10, 7:00am

The goal of this assignment is to provide feedback to your fellow students to help them assess the effectiveness of their completed interactive system design and their in-class project presentation. Your feedback will be given anonymously to the group you review. Your feedback will not affect their grade.

This review should be based on the P6 presentation which was presented in class and posted on the project's website. Try to limit yourself to two pages, as time for reading and grading is limited.

1. Summarize the overall goals of this project, including the revised data, target users and tasks.
2. Critique the revised scenarios. Are the users and tasks well defined and appropriate? Do they include sufficient detail to motivate the design?
3. Evaluate the final interactive visualization system design in light of the goals, target users and tasks.
 - a. Assess the effectiveness of overview and detail views, including encodings, presentation choices, and support for interaction. Are they understandable? Do they communicate what is needed clearly and effectively? Do they follow the principles we have learned in this class?
 - b. Assess the effectiveness of the interaction techniques and other system features in supporting the users and their tasks. Do they make sense? Do they support an appropriate subset of Shneiderman's infovis tasks (overview, zoom, filter, details-on-demand, relate, history, extract)?
4. Critique the overall quality of the presentation. Was it clear and complete? What would you improve?
