

オーラルインタビューについて、次のようなことをよく練習して来て下さい。

1. Interview your teacher: Pretending that you want to know your teacher's personal information, ask questions about your teacher's life and interests. Be sure to use the appropriate polite expressions.

You will be evaluated whether or not you can ask questions and interact in Japanese using the appropriate politeness.

You will also be evaluated for your ability to react to the responses you get. A higher grade will be given when you can engage in a conversation, rather than just simply ask a series of unrelated questions

2. Describe your childhood: Describe your childhood, with a special emphasis on the tasks you were made to do, things you were allowed to do, etc.

You will be evaluated whether or not you can use the appropriate grammatical voice (passive/causative/causative-passive/causative-benefactive) to express different degrees of affectedness.

3. Describe your daily life in Japanese: The instructor will ask questions about your daily life in Japanese. This part is more like a free conversation without any specific emphasis on particular grammatical constructions.

Your overall linguistic development in Japanese will be evaluated. We would like to see your spoken skills in Japanese at the level where you can talk about your daily routines with ease and in some depth, evidencing what you have learned in 2nd year Japanese. `

4. One minute speech on 困っていること.

We will evaluate how well-prepared you are for your presentation. It is important that you show that you understand what you are talking about and make every effort to include the grammatical constructions/expressions that you have learned in 2nd year Japanese.
