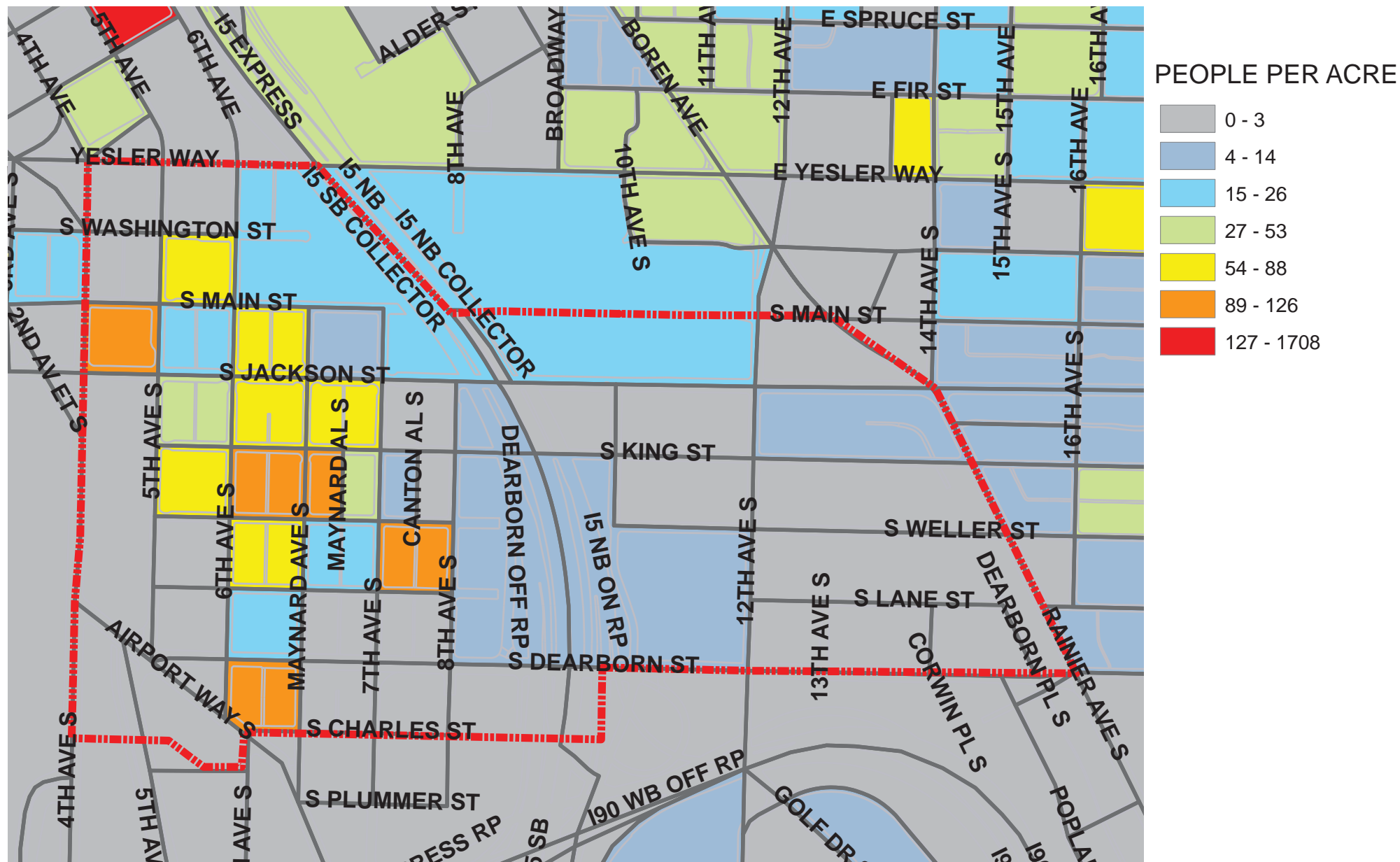

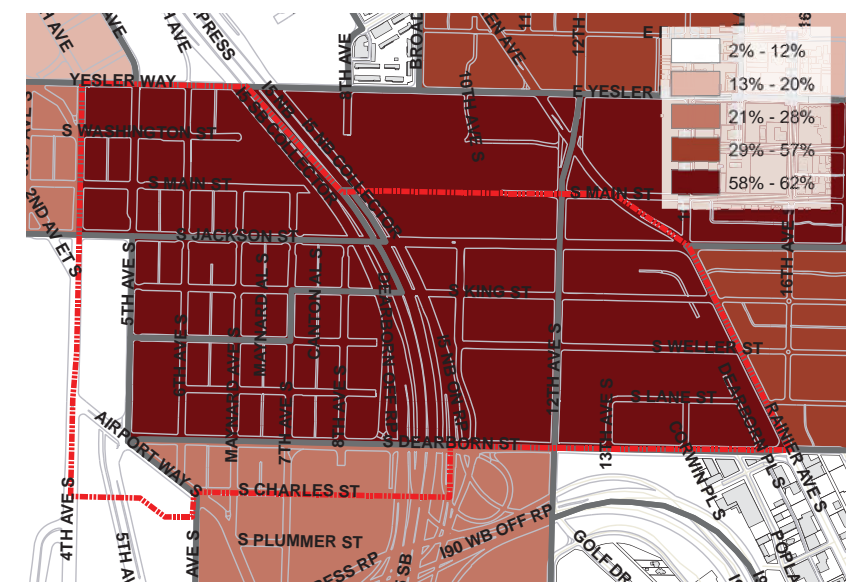

Number of foreign born people / population of Census 2000 block group.

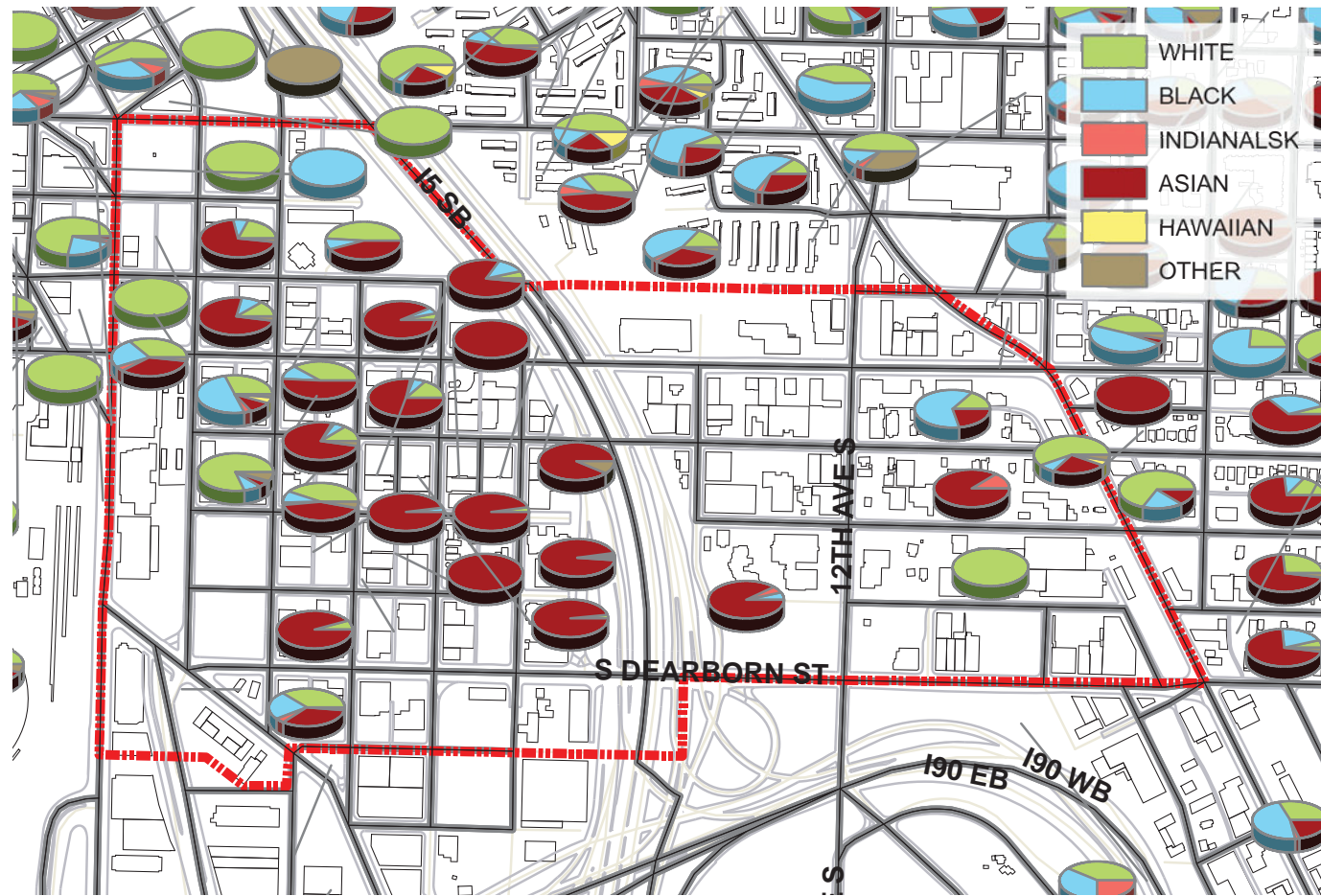
The human density map shows the location of existing housing developments and opportunities for a greater residential base.

The International District is characterized by a high foreign born population, a pan-Asian majority, and high numbers of low-income residents.

More elderly live in the district than youth, and they tend to be concentrated in a few blocks. In addition, most of the population is living alone, as demonstrated by the low average household sizes map. These indicate a need for more family housing.

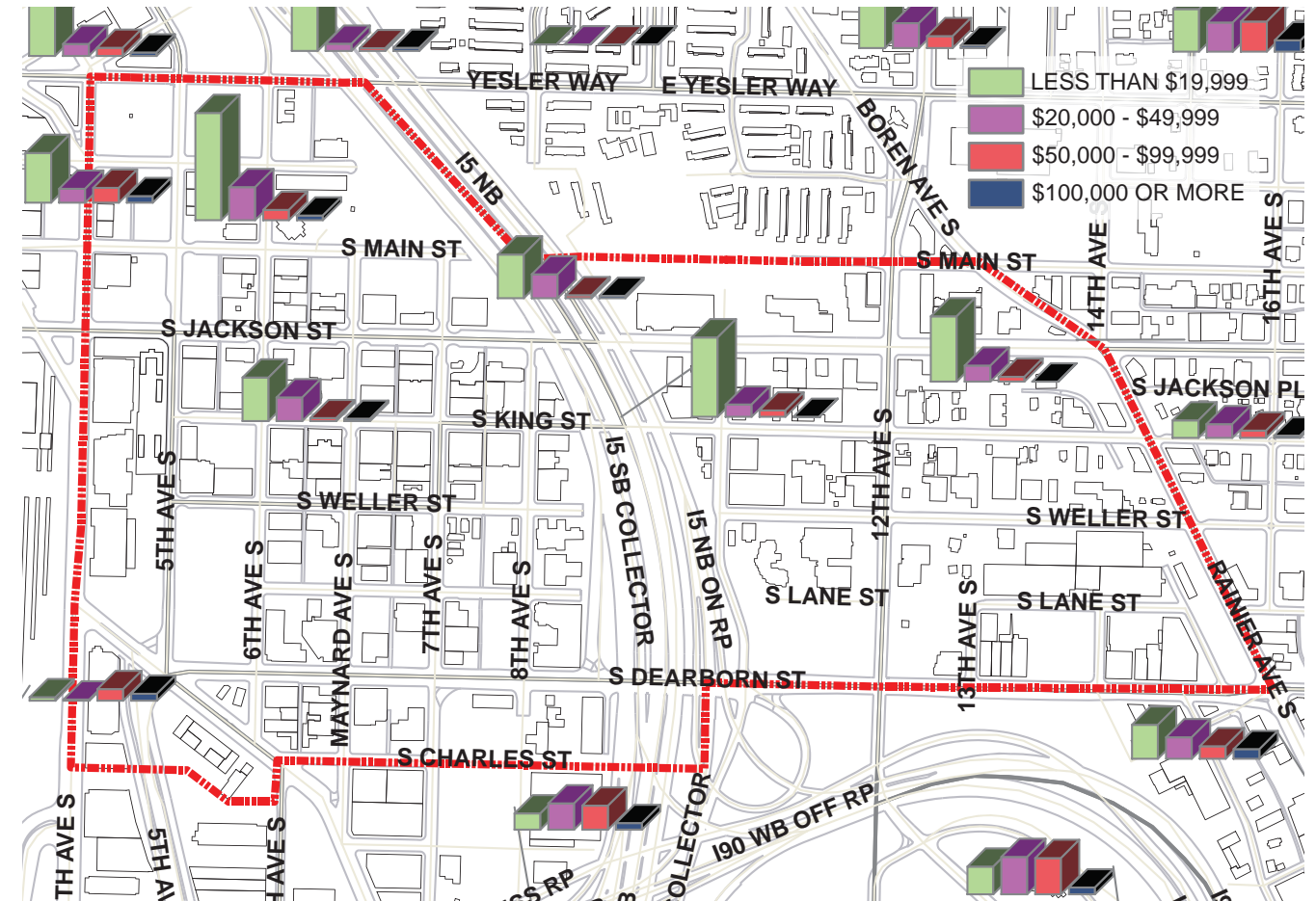
The vast majority of units are rented, with only 1% owned. Home ownership rates are often used in the U.S. to indicate general wealth or poverty of a neighborhood. The extremely low rate of ownership in this district could indicate a less wealthy and less established community than other Seattle neighborhoods.

POPULATION BY RACE

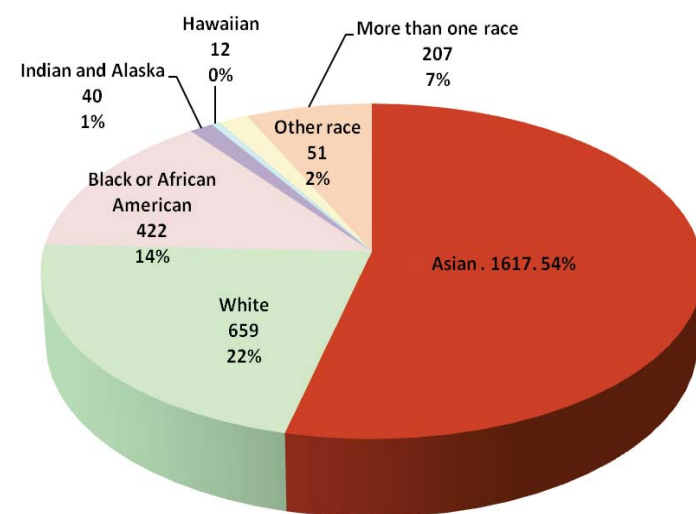


Fraction of racial group populations per Census 2000 block total population.

HOUSEHOLD INCOME LEVEL



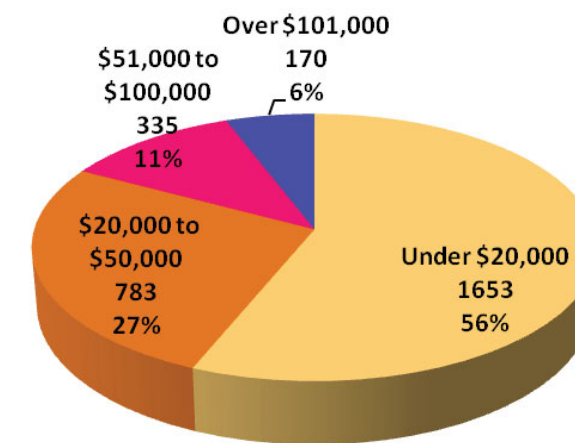
Number of people in each income group per Census 2000 block group.

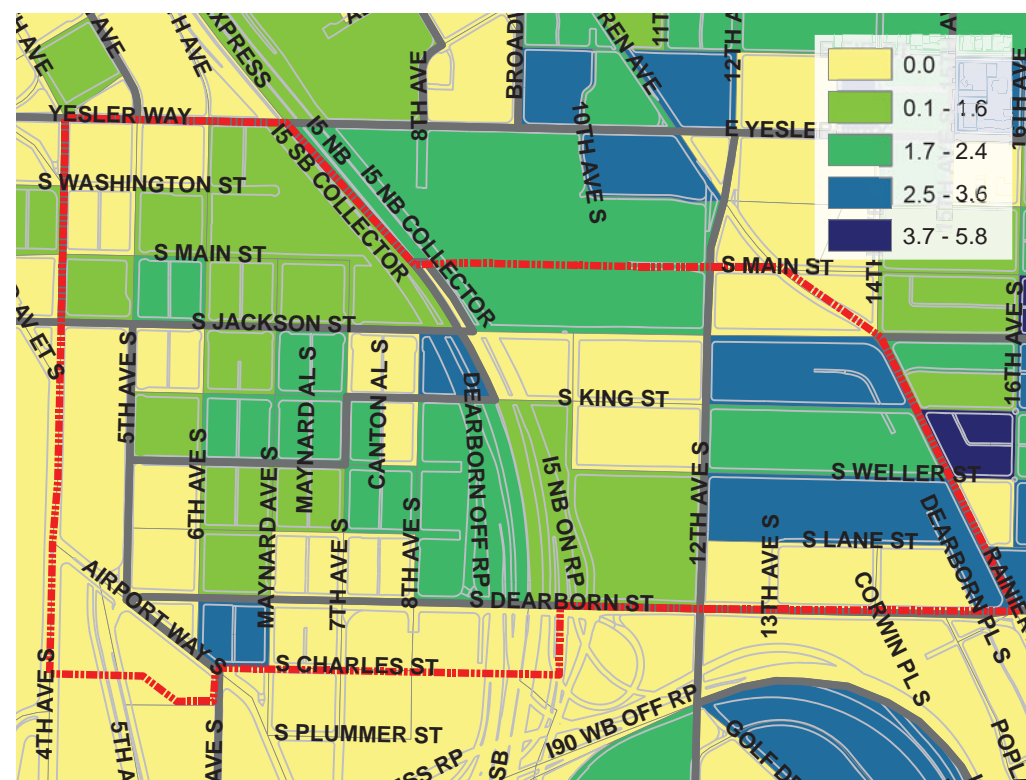

Household Income Level for Block groups

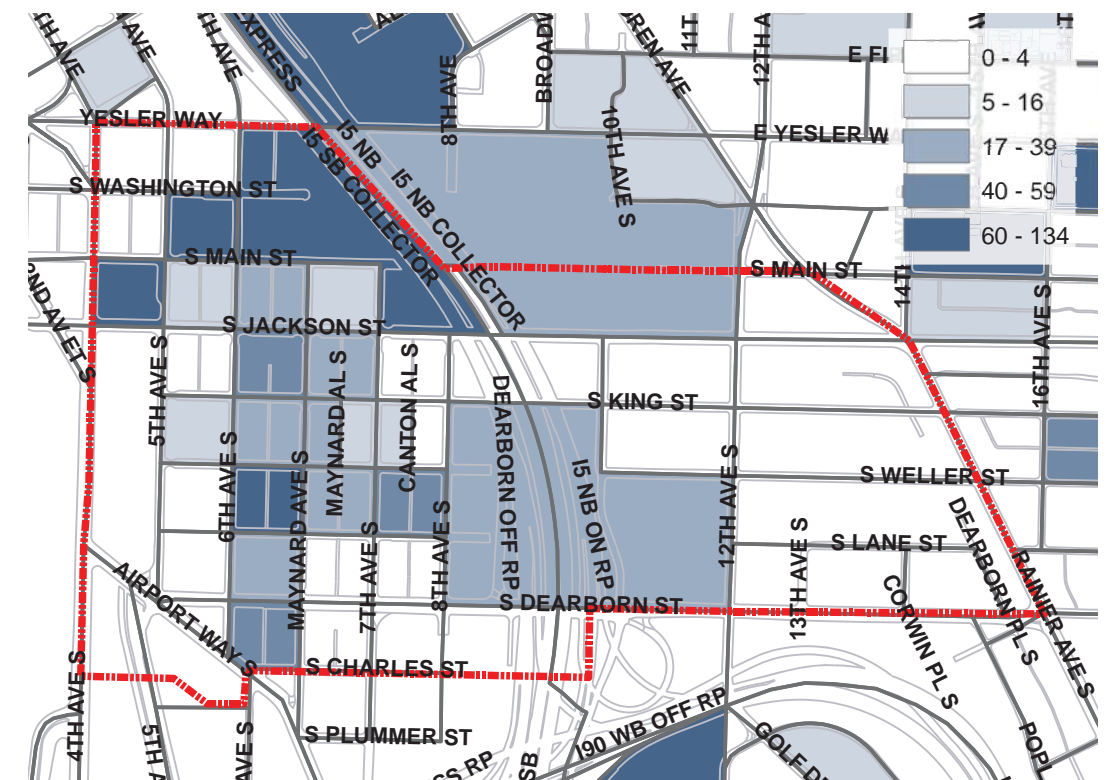

AVERAGE HOUSEHOLD SIZE



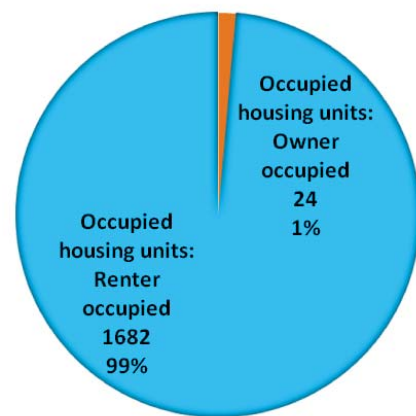
Average number of people in households by Census 2000 blocks.

ELDERLY (65 AND OLDER)



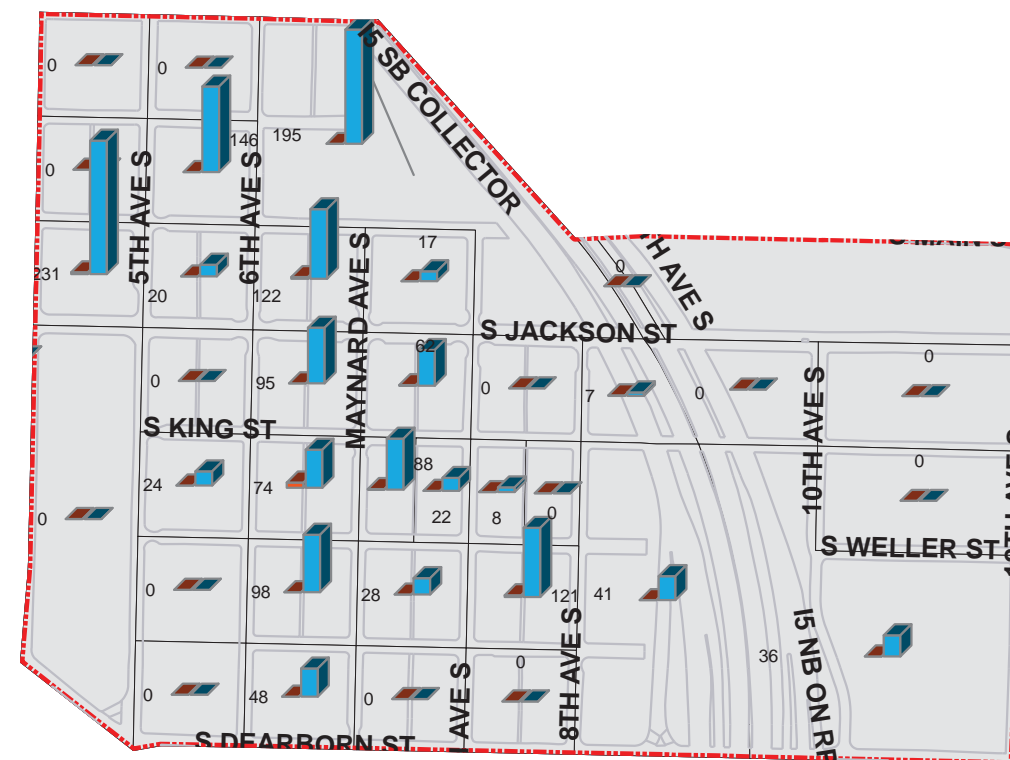
Number of elderly in Census 2000 block.

OCCUPIED HOUSING STATUS



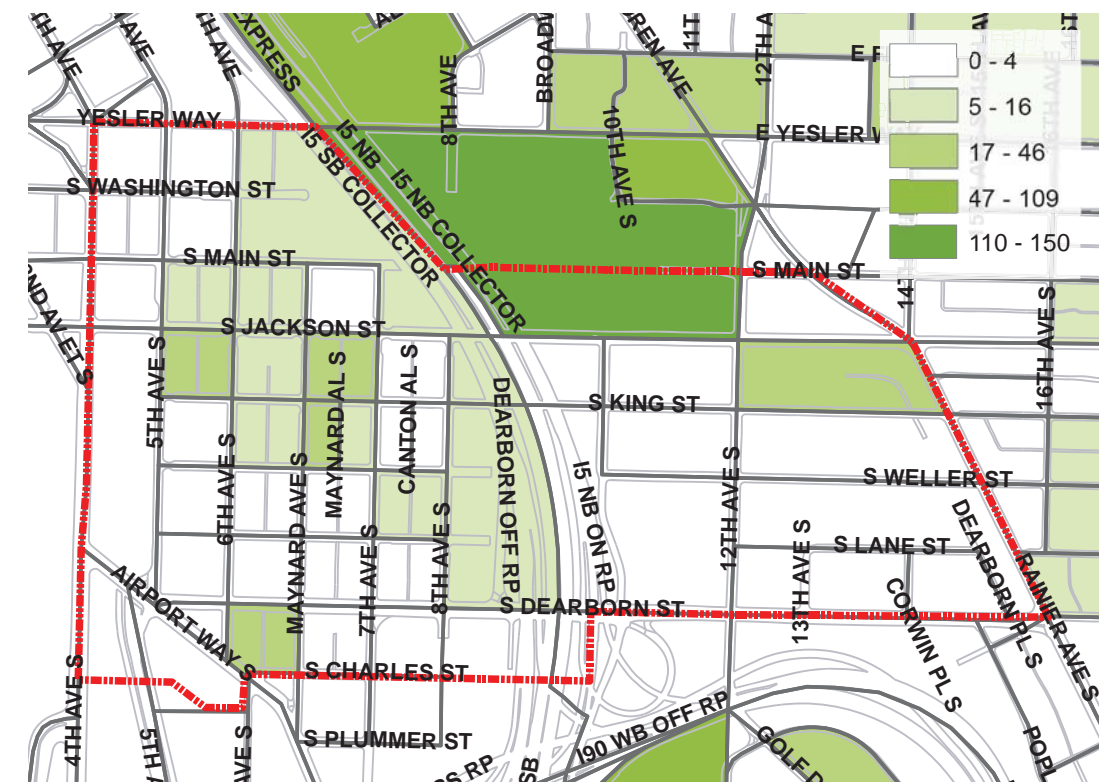

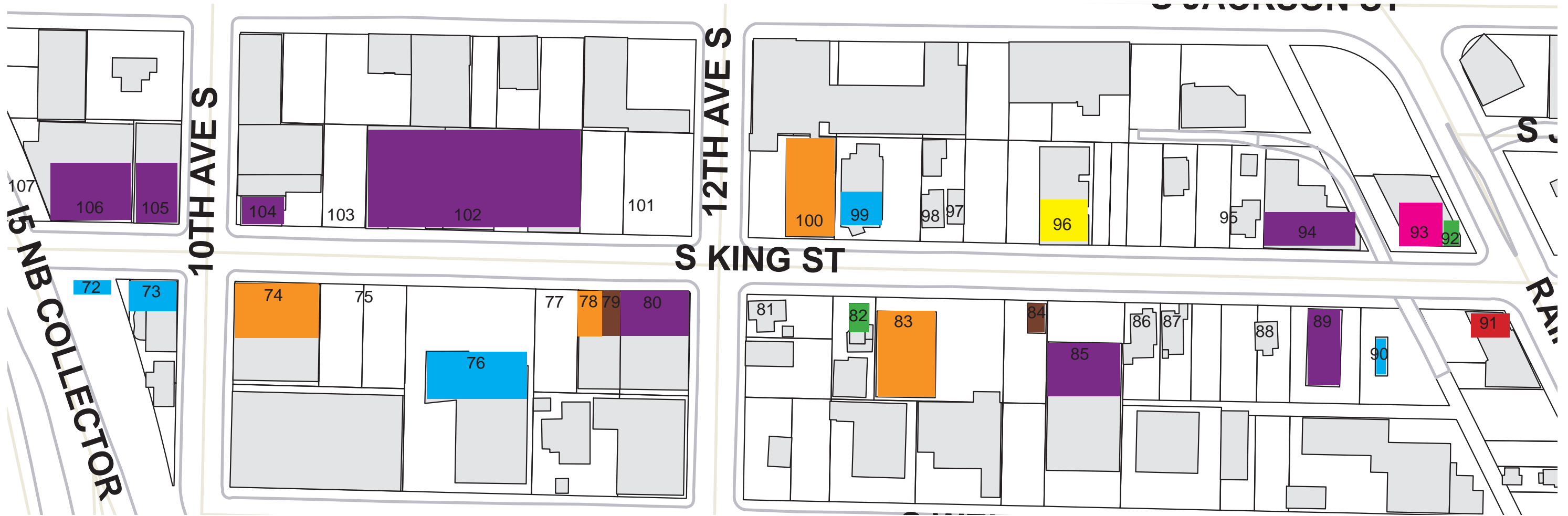
