A. Bioethics

CINAHL

A bibliographic database indexing over 1,200 journal from 1982 to the present.

LOCATORplus

The National Library of medicine's catalog of books, journals, and audiovisuals and access points to other medical research tools.

MEDLINE

Medline covers nearly 4500 journal in biomedicine and health from 1966 to the present. Coverage includes journal articles, letters, editorials, and case studies (but not meeting abstracts or book reviews) on biomedicine, nursing, dentistry, veterinary medicine, allied health, public health, health policy development and biological and physical sciences. PubMed, a service of the National Library of Medicine, provides access to MEDLINE citations back to the mid-1960s. When searching MEDLINE it is possible to limit the search scope to the subset "Bioethics."(formerly BIOETHICSLINE). Other MEDLINE subsets include History of Medicine (formerly HITSLINE), Nursing Journals, AIDS (formerly AIDSLINE).

MEDLINEplus

A service of the National Library of Medicine providing health information related to health topics, drug information, dictionaries, directories, and other resources.

PsychoINFO

A bibliographic database published by the American Psychological Association that indexes over 1,300 journals from 1872 to the present.

Web of Science

A bibliographic database published by ISI, the Institute for Scientific Information, Inc., which includes Science Citation Index, Social Sciences Citation Index and Arts & Humanities Citation Index. Coverage is from 1975 to the present.

B. Philosophy

PHILOSOPHERS' INDEX.

The PHILOSOPHERS' INDEX provides indexing and abstracts from books and journals of philosophy and related fields. It covers the areas of ethics, aesthetics, social philosophy, political philosophy, epistemology, metaphysics, and logic, as well as material on the philosophy of law, religion, science, history, education and language.

Directory of American Philosophers

(Covers Canada and the U.S. Updated biannually. Lists philosophy departments, research institutes, and societies, with address, phone number, and faculty/members. Also lists philosophical journals and states name, phone number, and address of editors; kinds of articles considered/given preference; review process; percentage of manuscripts received that are accepted.)

International Directory of Philosophy and Philosophers.

(Similar to the Directory described above, but covers places outside Canada and the U.S.)

Proceedings of the American Philosophical Association.

(Published four times per year for APA members. Includes much useful information, such as programs for Pacific, Central and Eastern division APA conferences and calls for papers by philosophical societies. Student membership offered at a discount price.)
