

Extra Credit Opportunities:

Each student has the opportunity to earn 20 points of extra credit during the quarter.

Become a SoundCitizen (5 points)

Request a kit from SoundCitizen (<http://soundcitizen.org/>). Follow the online instructions and the instructions that come in the kit. *Please only request a kit if you intend on collecting and returning a water sample.*

To receive extra credit points, submit a document to the instructor that includes the following information:

- Bar Code # for your sampling kit/water sample
- Location name and GPS coordinates
- Sample type (i.e., stream, gutter, Sound, etc.)
- Sample date
- Brief description of why you picked the sample type and location

Visit the Seattle Aquarium (10 points)

Visit the Seattle Aquarium anytime during the quarter to touch and explore something new and exciting. Before you go, print out the “Aquarium Visit” worksheet available through the “Lectures & Assignments” link on the course website. Complete the worksheet and give it to your TA after your visit. Be sure to save and attach your admission ticket to the completed worksheet. **Full credit will not be given unless ticket is attached.** The last day to turn in the worksheet is Dec. 11th.
