- PHYS 122 Lab is a Graded Part of the 5 Credit Course.
- Begins **THE SECOND WEEK OF CLASSES.**
- Purchase the Lab Manual (~ \$10) at the University Bookstore.
- Bring it to Lab Each Week Beginning Next Week.
- Worksheets for 2 or 3 Student Partners.
- All Work is Done in the Lab Session. Do NOT Bring Partially or Fully Completed Worksheets to Lab.
- Designed to Help Relate Theory to the Real World.
- Coordinated (NOT SYNCHRONIZED) With Lecture.
- TAs Will Not Give Answers, But Will Help Your Group.
- It is About Observing, Measuring, and Deducing.
- Lab Worksheets are Graded on a 5 Point Scale, 5 = Exceptional and 1 = Just Barely Better Than Nothing.
- Class Average Should Be About 3.5/5.
- The Last Lab (#8) is a Universal Make-up Lab That Can Replace any One Missed Lab From the First Seven Labs.
- If You Miss (Score Zero For) One Lab Without Making It Up, Your Overall Course Grade Will Drop By a Huge Amount (Approximately 1.3 Standard Deviations, ~ 0.8 / 4.0).
