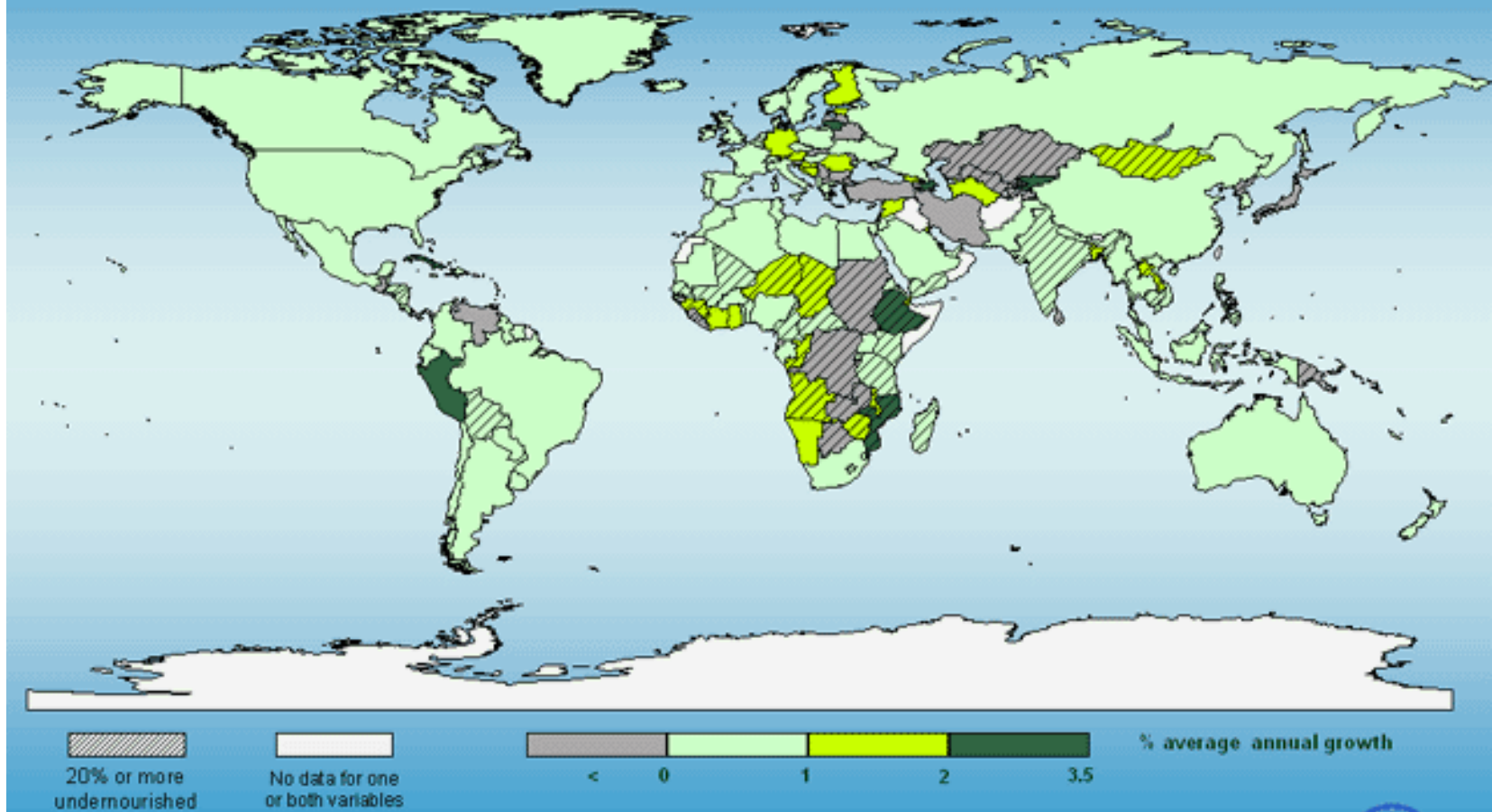


Growth in Food Consumption (1995-2001)



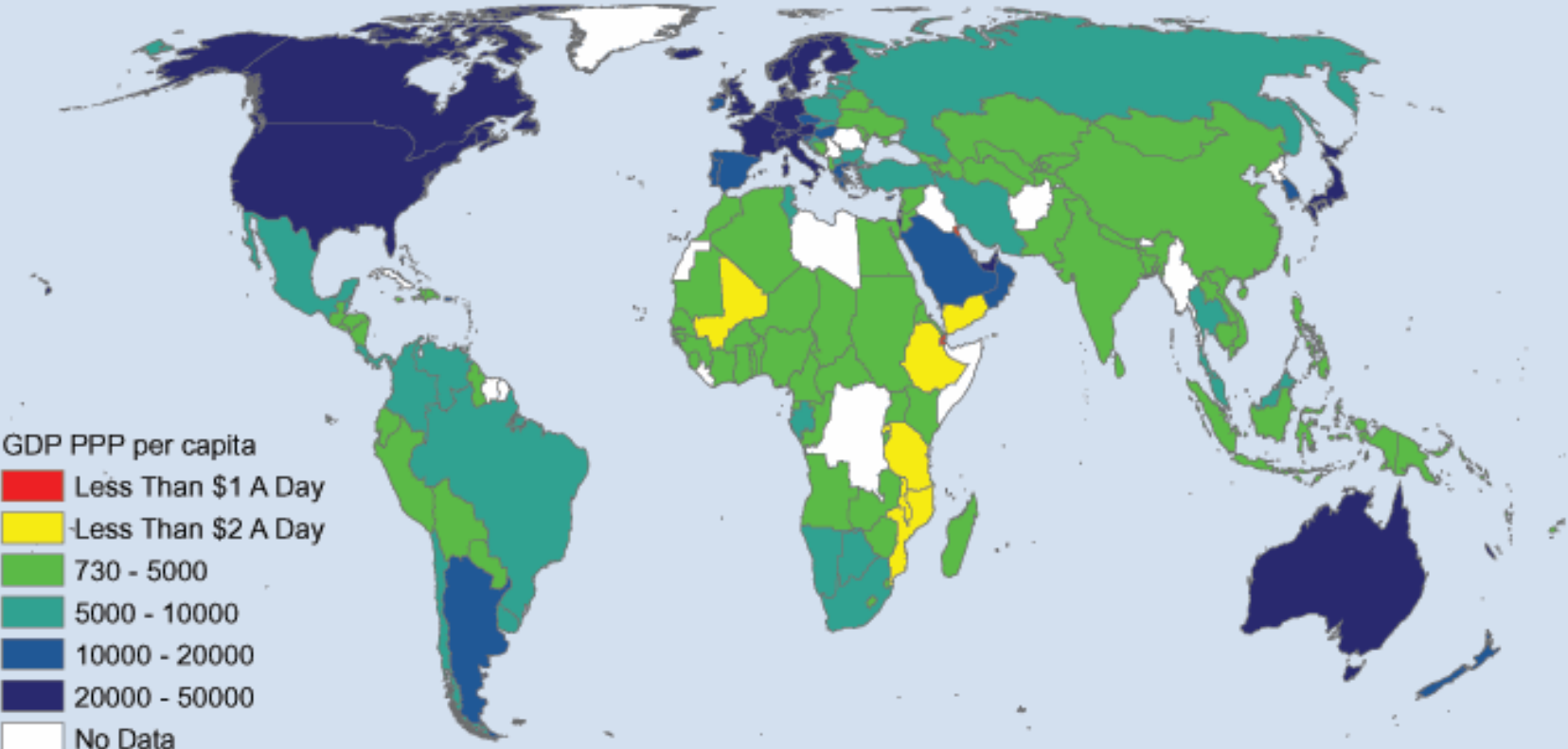

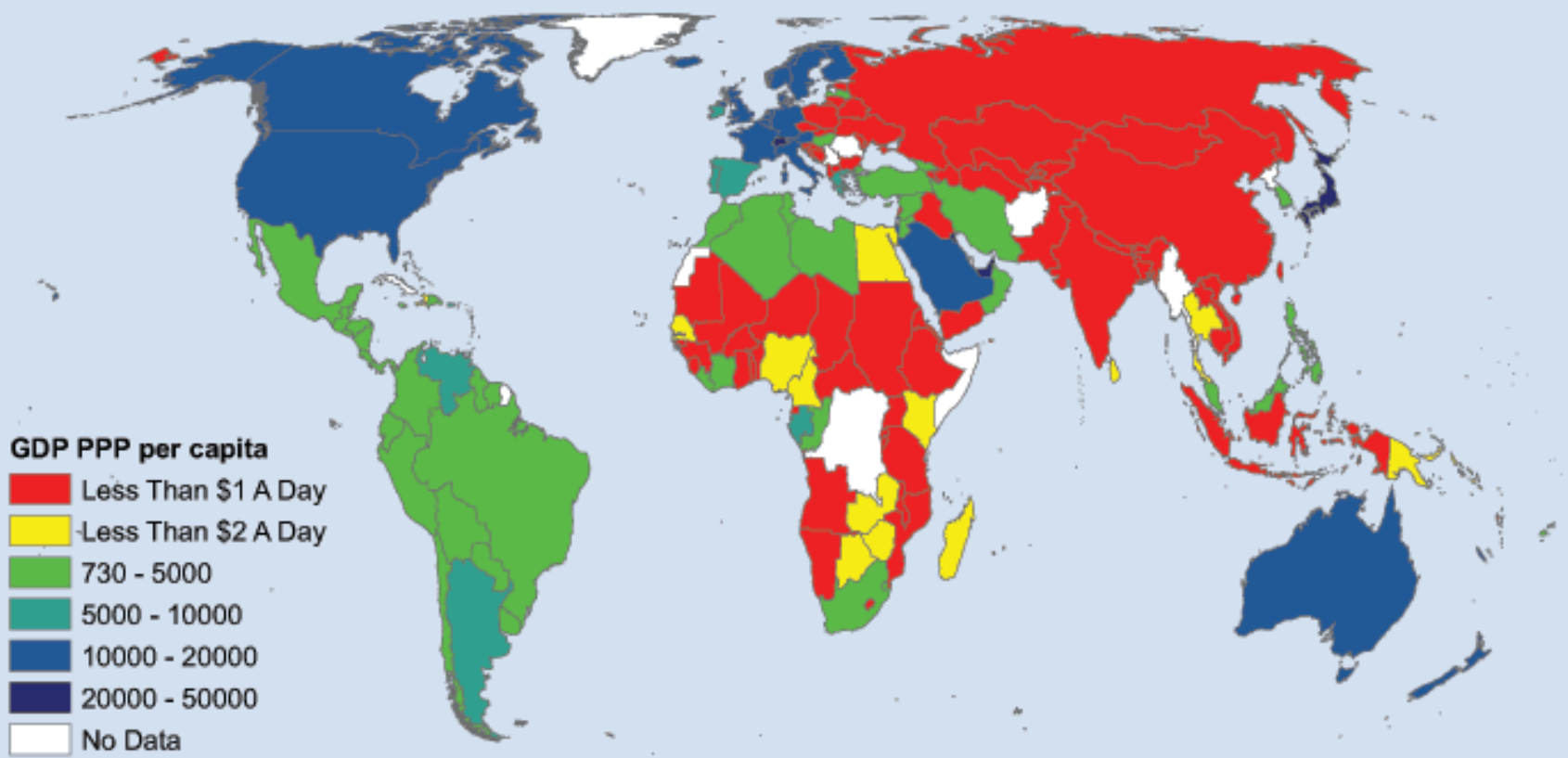

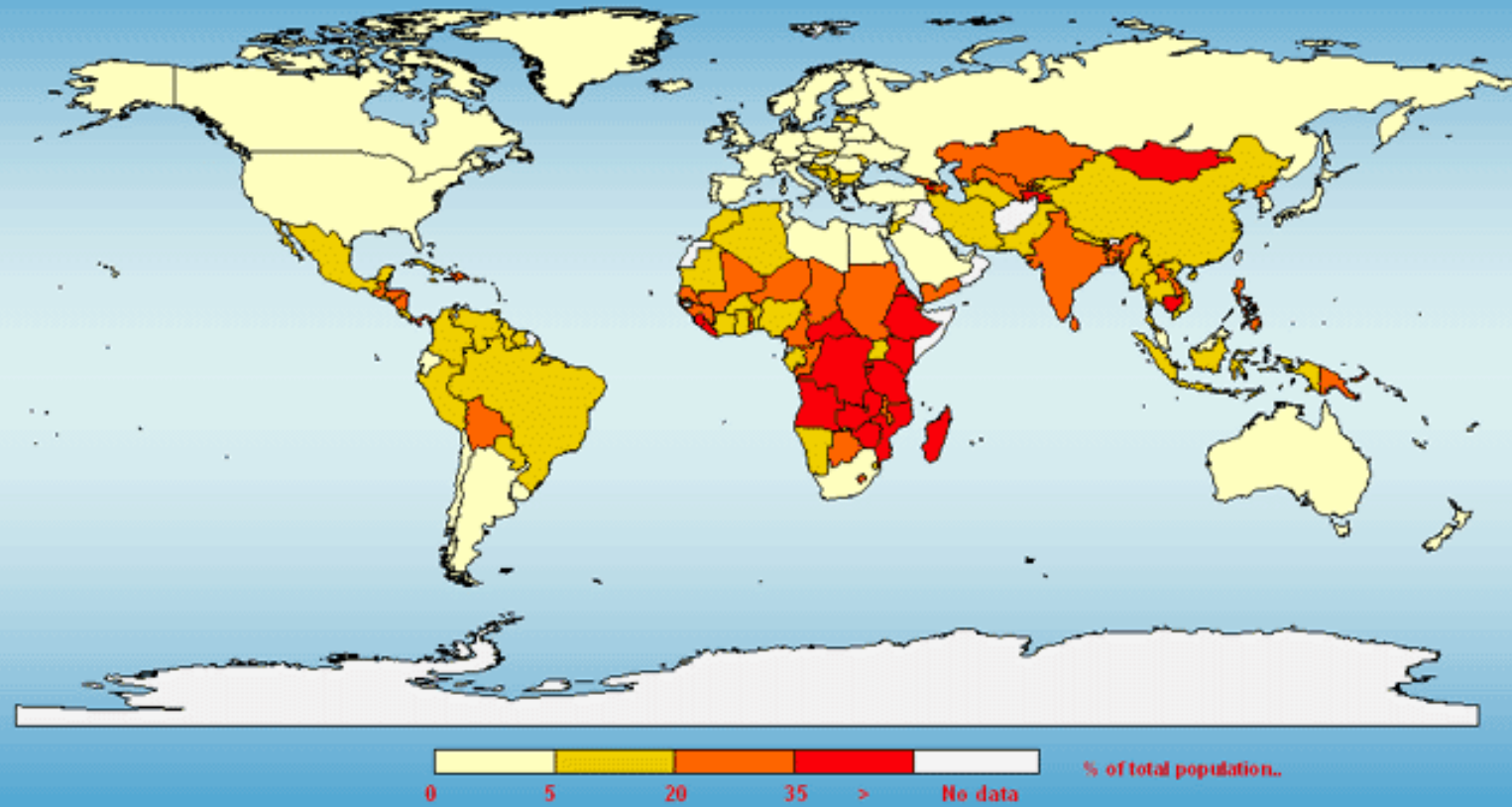

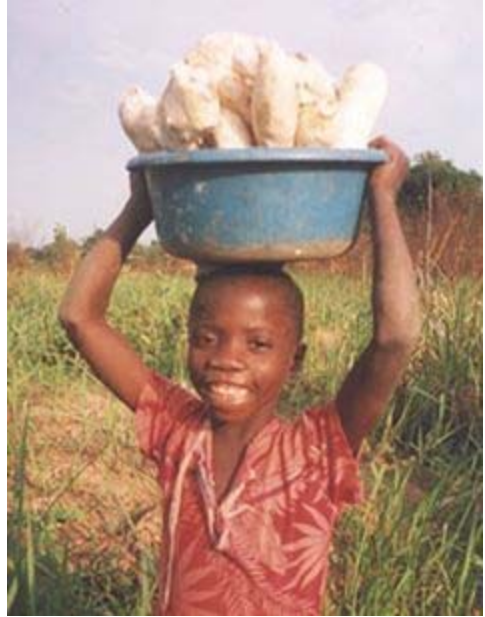
Undernourished Population (1999-2001)



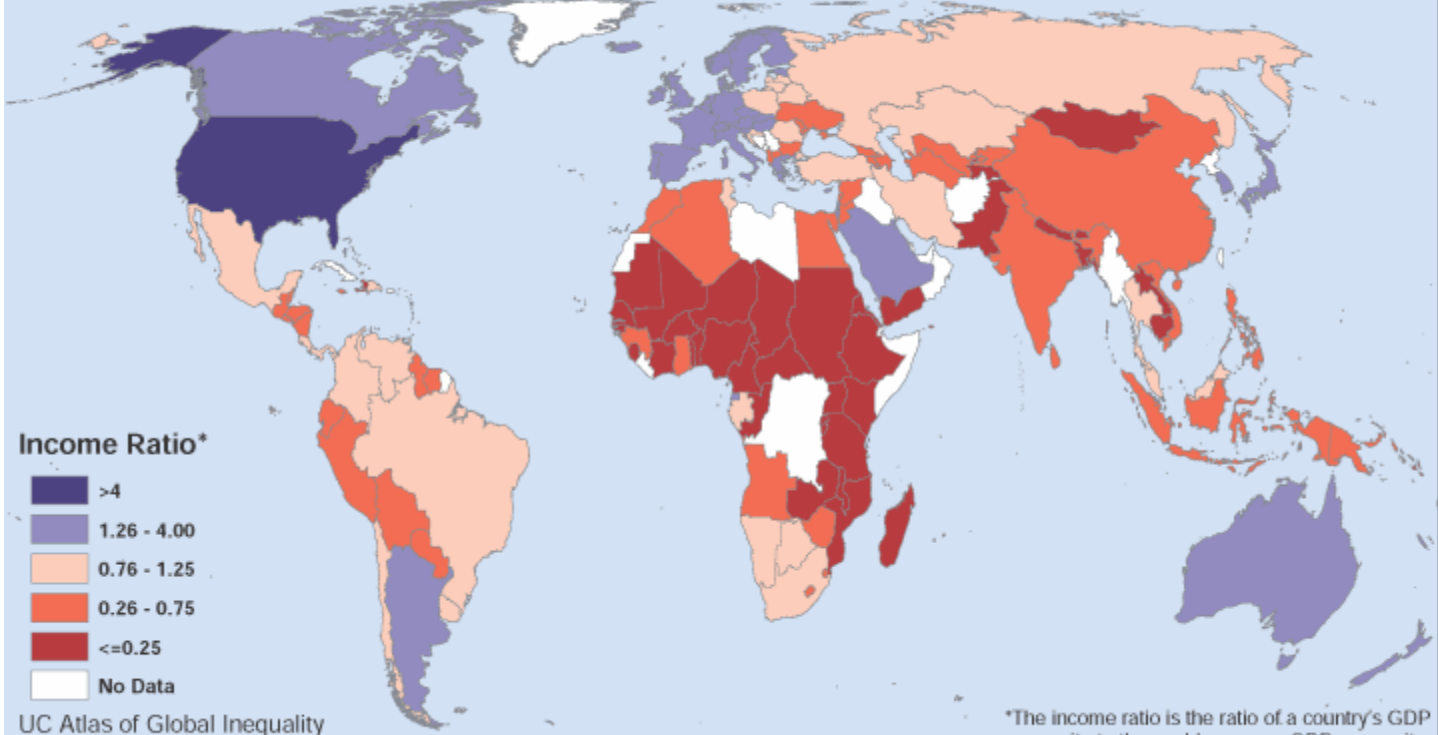

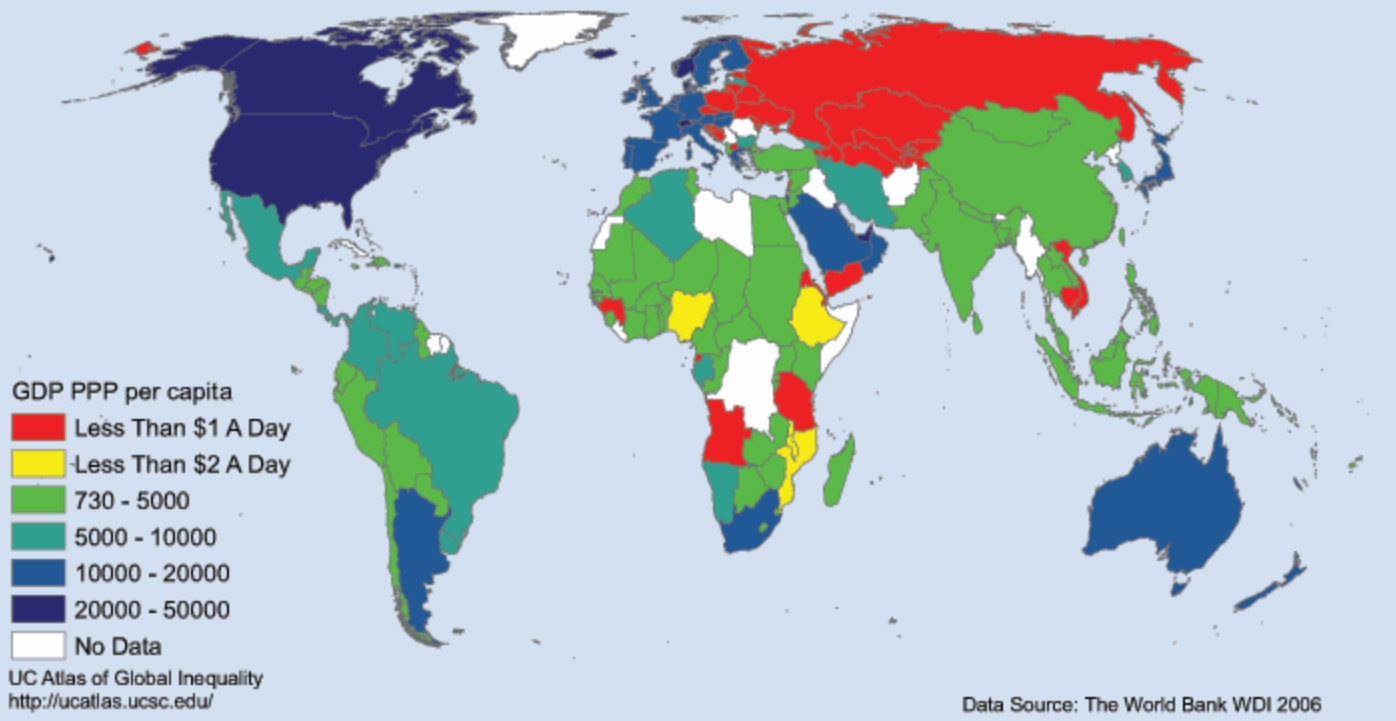

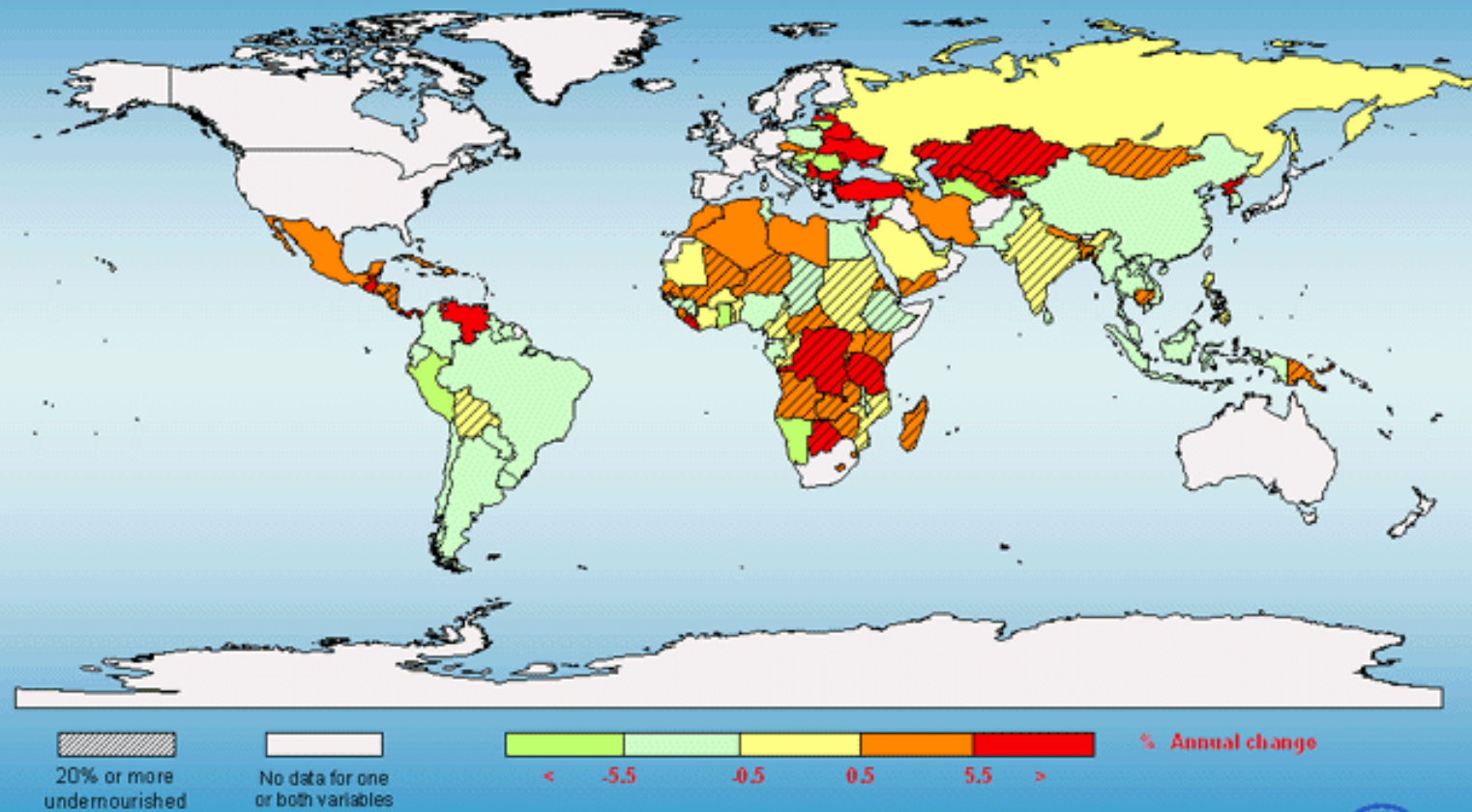


GDP (PPP) per capita 1984





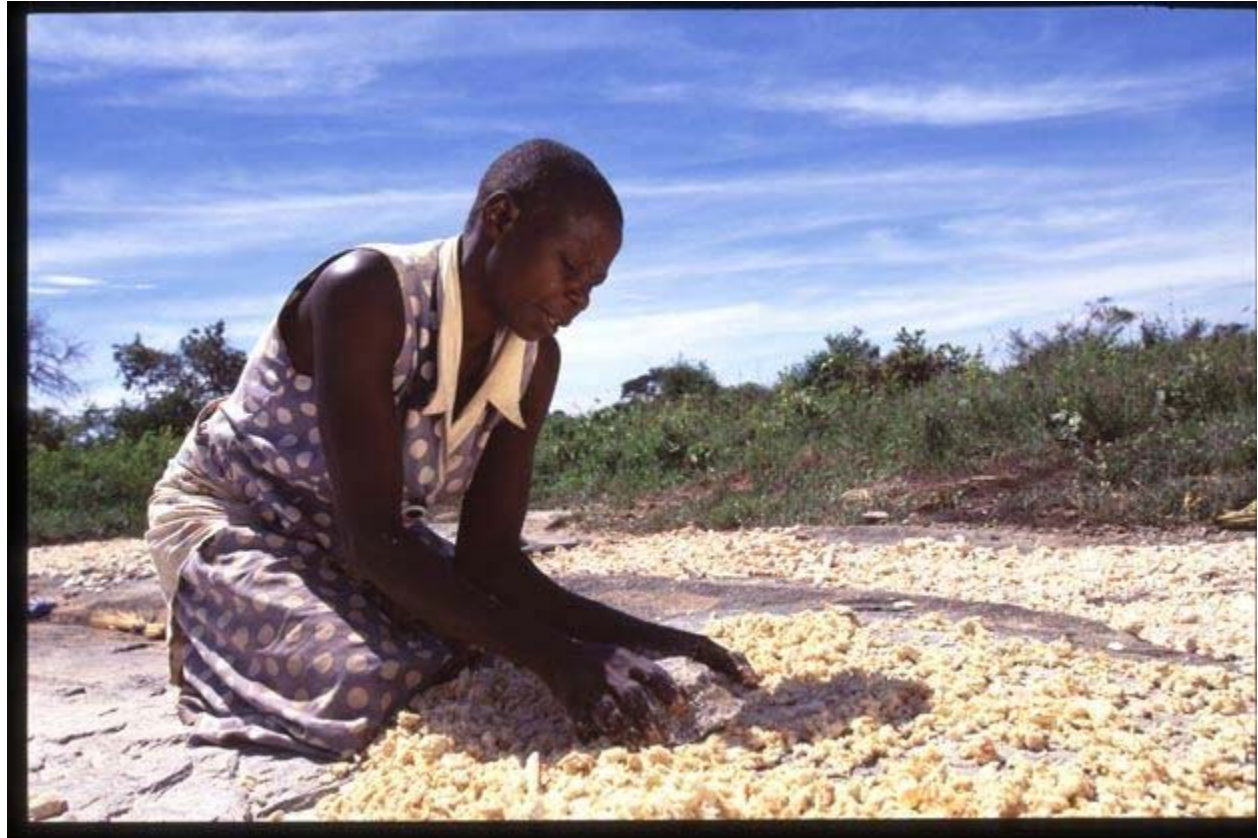
Change in Number of Undernourished (1990's)

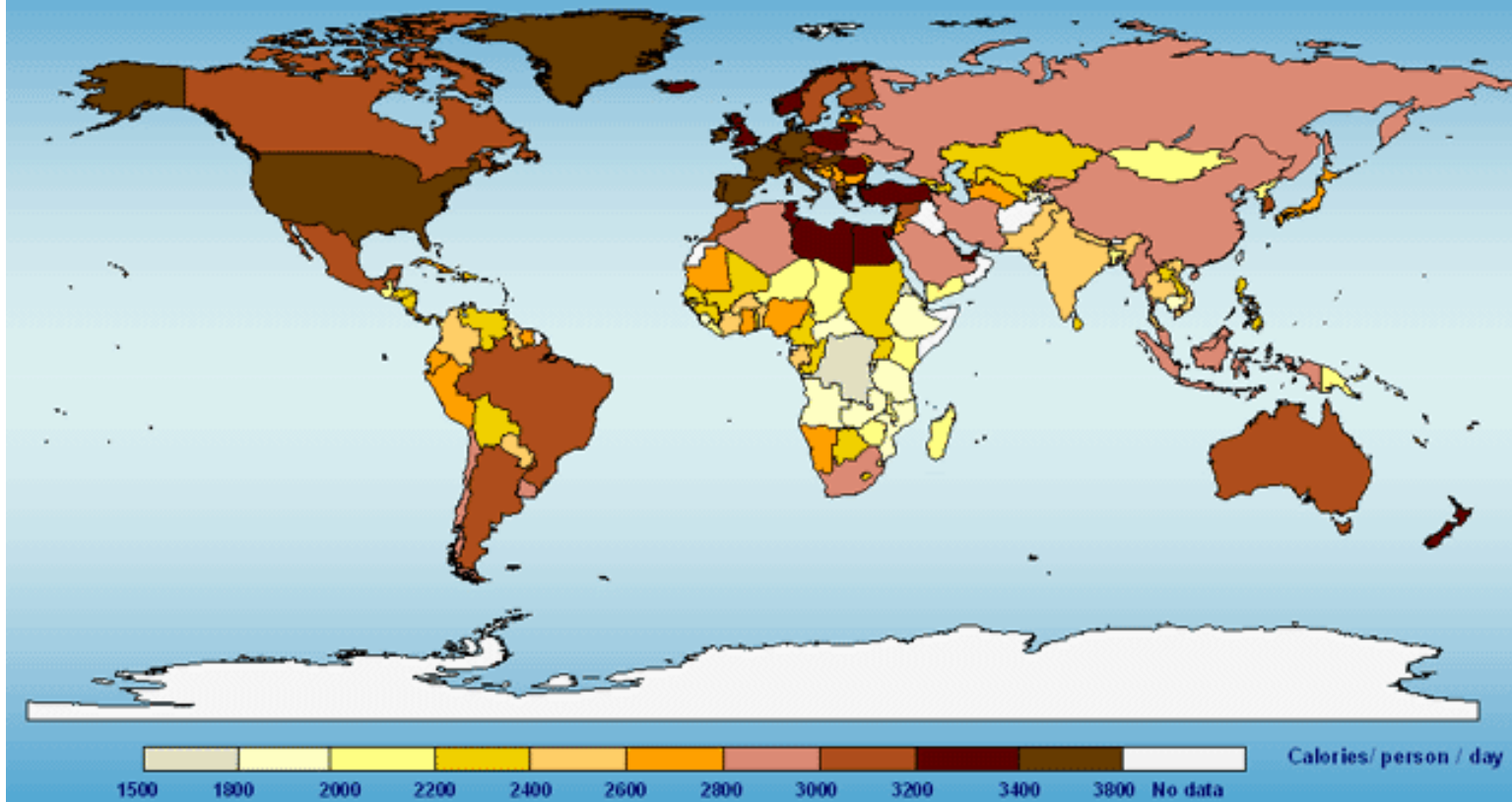
